U.S. Court Records and the Federal Record **Centers**

After a federal case is closed, the documents are held by the federal courts location for a predetermined number of years. This can be as little as six months, or, rarely, until the court reaches its capacity to store files. The closed cases are then sent to and stored at a designated Federal Records Center (FRC). These offices are administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA). See www.archives.gov/research

The National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) provides access to archived court records exclusively by online ordering or by mail or fax. NARA no longer provides on-site court case review services to the public at its Federal Records Centers.

This procedure applies to all closed bankruptcy, civil, criminal, and court of appeals case files that remain in the legal custody of the courts but are physically stored at NARA's Federal Records Centers.
